## Risk Management

**Southend Minor Hockey Association** does not recommend House League Players participate in contact tournaments due to an increased potential for injury in such competition. House League players are not routinely instructed in body contact, nor do they compete in regular play where body contact is permitted.

Should a Southend Hockey Association House League coach desires the team to participate in a contact tournament, the team must meet and decide as a group that they wish to participate.

If the majority agrees and there is an adequate number of players, the team can enter the contact tournament.

The team must also arrange for body contact clinics to prepare the players for the competition.

All parents and players must sign a waiver.
